Flu documentation is due to the school by December 1st. The last community event, that does not require an appointment, is in Baumholder for all DoD ID holders. Otherwise, flu administration will only be given on an appointment-based system. Please do not wait until the last minute to try to make appointments for your students.

Appointments are limited, please make your student's appointment as soon as possible.

Instructions for making appointments:

Appointments must be scheduled through the Digital Appointment Portal:

https://informatics-stage.health.mil/DAP/

- 1. Select Germany, then LRMC, then Landstuhl Regional Medical Center Mass Flu Vaccination Drive, and then select Child Immunization for students, and Annual Flu Vaccine for adults.
- 2. After you have selected a date, you will be prompted to enter a DoD ID Number for you child. If they are under 10, and they don't have an ID/CAC card yet, please refer to the instructions attached in the flyer.
- 3. If you are a civilian and you have never received care at LRMC before, please register with PAD (Patient Administration) first. They can be reached at 06371-9464-5202 or 5203.

Remember Parents/Guardians, the flu shot is an annual requirement for continued enrollment in DoDEA schools and is due by December 1st! Documentation must be emailed to: dorinda.savchenko@dodea.edu or brought into the school.

<u> Martinstag – St. Martin's Day</u>

Every year on November 11, people in Germany celebrate St. Martin's Day. Children parade from church to a public place singing and holding lanterns they made at school or in Kindergarten. A man dressed up as St. Martin, riding a horse, leads the parade. With their songs, the children honor St. Martin, who was a missionary in France, bishop of Tours, friend of the children and patron of the poor.

Legend says that one cold winter night, the soldier St. Martin was riding on his horse. On his way, he found this poor old beggar in rags sitting by the road asking for alms. Since Martin had neither food nor money with him, he cut his warm cloak into half and gave one of the pieces to the beggar. So, at least, the beggar could be warm.

This story is usually acted out at a bonfire at the ending place of the parade. Traditionally, pretzels, hot tea, "Glühwein" etc. are available for purchase.

In Ramstein, the parade traditionally starts every year at the Catholic Church St. Nikolaus in the <u>center of the town at 18:00 h</u>. Everybody is invited to attend. It is a public event.
